

New Forest winery Beaulieu 58 to launch debut range of wines

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A new winery is launching its first range of English still wines.

Beaulieu 58 Winery, located in the New Forest, has created its debut collection, which includes an award-winning white and red wine, as well as a rosé.

It claims to have combined "innovative" growing techniques with traditional, low-intervention winemaking methods in order to create the wines.

The winery was founded by Sandy Booth, who is an expert in sustainable farming and has decades of experience in fruit production.
